Current median household income is \$38,031 in the area, compared to \$56,124 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$40,937 in five years, compared to \$62,316 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$60,542 in this area, compared to \$80,675 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$67,527 in five years, compared to \$91,585 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$26,464 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$30,820. The per capita income is projected to be \$29,470 in five years, compared to \$34,828 for all U.S. households

Currently, 42.2% of the 57,367 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 46.4%, renter occupied; and 11.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 53,859 housing units in the area - 45.4% owner occupied, 44.0% renter occupied, and 10.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.84%. Median home value in the area is \$124,124, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.12% annually to \$137,834.
